

## COVID POLICY for Dreamshadow Workshop & Training at Pendle Hill

All participants will be considered Pendle Hill Conference Center guests and are required to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 in advance of coming to Pendle Hill. Currently, “fully vaccinated” means two weeks past the second shot of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna) or two weeks after receiving the single shot of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. We also strongly encourage everyone to get boosted, though it is not a requirement of attending at this time.

***To submit proof of vaccination, please email either a photo or a pdf of your vaccination card to [contact@dreamshadow.com](mailto:contact@dreamshadow.com) as part of your registration. Your registration will not be complete without this proof of vaccination.***

Currently at Pendle Hill, masks are required indoors, except when eating or in one’s private room, or in our meeting/teaching/breathwork space.

A few days before your arrival at Pendle Hill, you will be sent a link to complete an online prescreening and waiver form, which is required by Pendle Hill. ***Please complete this form by 6 pm the day before your arrival.*** It will ask you to provide information and agree to certain conditions, including:

- Providing contact information in a way that would be useful to any necessary contact tracing.
- Affirming that you have provided proof of full vaccination to us as requested in the second paragraph above.
- Stating whether you have COVID or symptoms of COVID, have been exposed to COVID, or are waiting on the results of a COVID test. If you report symptoms of COVID on the waiver, you may be contacted by a staff person and/or one of us from Dreamshadow to evaluate risk and explore options. You may be asked not to come to Pendle Hill, in which case we will refund your payment. If you test positive for COVID at any point within 14 days of your planned arrival, we ask that you not attend and will refund your payment.
- Affirming that you will release and hold harmless Pendle Hill from liability arising from damages related to COVID-19.
- Stating that you will comply with a variety of COVID-19 safety measures that are in place on campus or that may be put in place.
- Providing contact information for an emergency contact person who has agreed to be responsible to help make arrangements (transportation, medical care, etc.) for the guest, should they become too sick from COVID-19 to make these arrangements for themselves.

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
